Expression of Interest

Inviting

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1) Preamble / Background:-

Mahatma Phule Renewable Energy and Infrastructure Limited ("MAHAPREET") has been incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013 as a subsidiary of Mahatma Phule Backward Class Development Corporation Ltd., which functions under the Social Justice & Special Assistance Department, Government of Maharashtra ("GoM"). Vide Government Resolution No. Sankirna-2022/Pra.Kra.29/Mahamandale dated 10th July 2023, GoM has granted MAHAPREET permission to undertake Government-to-Government (G2G) work, i.e., to accept and execute assignments on behalf of State Government departments, semi-government departments, local bodies, Municipal Corporations and other public agencies, subject to strict compliance with prevailing government rules, laws, policies and orders, and subject to the condition that no financial burden or loss shall accrue to the Government.

As per the said Government Resolution, MAHAPREET is mandated to undertake projects across ten identified thematic areas, namely: (i) Akshaya Urja, EV charging infrastructure and vehicles; (ii) agricultural process value chain and bio-fuel; (iii) basic infrastructure projects, STP and data centres; (iv) energy efficiency, audit and ESCO projects; (v) affordable housing and urban planning; (vi) women entrepreneurship; (vii) environment and climate change; (viii) health, bio-science and well-being; (ix) emerging technology and futuristic energy integration; and (x) corporate group development and CSR. MAHAPREET is further required to form Special Purpose Vehicles/Joint Ventures with State and Central PSUs and Urban Local Bodies, and to set up Centres of Excellence and Incubation Centres in furtherance of these objectives.

Given the breadth and inter-departmental nature of this mandate, MAHAPREET requires the support of experienced and credible professionals who understand government functioning as well as industry practice, to identify business opportunities, build institutional relationships, and facilitate the smooth execution of G2G assignments. MAHAPREET therefore invites this Expression of Interest from (a) retired officers of the All India Services (AIS), and (b) domain experts from the corporate sector, to be empanelled as Key Resource Persons (KRPs).

2) MAHAPREET Information: -

- I. Mahatma Phule Renewable Energy and Infrastructure Technology Ltd (MAHAPREET) -**
MAHAPREET was set up in April 2021 to venture into RE and Green technology areas and infrastructure projects as fully owned subsidiary of MPBCDC and the Govt. of

Maharashtra has allowed to take up RE and Green energy, Infrastructure projects on Govt-to-Govt basis (G2G basis) vide GR dated 10th July 2023. Government of Maharashtra has set up the "Mahatma Phule Backward Classes Development Corporation on July 10, 1978 under the Companies Act, 1956 with the main objective of accelerating the economic upliftment of the economically weaker families of SC communities in the State of Maharashtra. The ratio of shareholding between State and Central Government is 51:49 % respectively having authorized share capital of Rs. 1000 Crore.

II. MAHAPREIT having objectives to establish and carry-on business of Generating, Trading, Operating, Leasing and Renting Renewable Power Projects, mainly but not limited to Solar Power Projects including Solar Parks along with sub-stations and transmission lines on ownership and/or build, own and transfer basis. Further objects are to establish and/or carry on business in relation to Decarbonization and energy efficiency, battery storage solutions, alternative fuel cell technology and climate change issues in accordance with Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) schemes/policies or Ministry of Power or any such department of Govt of India (GoI) and its PSU/companies and Govt of Maharashtra (GoM) Energy dept's Renewable Energy Policy as amended from time to time and all incidental and allied activities required for such business.

III. NAVYUG SCHEME: -

MAHAPREIT implements "NAVYUG SCHEME" to get the integrated, inclusive and comprehensive effects of all the input supports of MAHAPREIT company to the target beneficiaries of MPBCDC Limited as defined from time to time by Govt of Maharashtra. MAHAPREIT undertakes such projects under different verticals like –

- i. Renewable Energy with Solar Power, hybrid and RE centric Projects,
- ii. ESCO model Energy saving Scheme for ULB & Govt of Maharashtra agencies.
- iii. Argo Processing Value Chain and Biofuels,
- iv. Affordable Housing, ARHS and schemes under MoUHA, GoI under EWS and PMAY,
- v. Highway and Infrastructure Projects,
- vi. Environment and Climate Change,
- vii. New and Emerging Technology Projects especially in Green Hydrogen, Futuristic Energy Integration Projects,
- viii. Software Technology and Application-Based Services and CSR Projects.

3) Objective of this EOI:-

The objective of this EOI is to identify, evaluate and empanel suitable individuals as Key Resource Persons who will support MAHAPREIT's business development function and facilitate G2G engagements with GoM departments, its boards, corporations, agencies, Urban Local Bodies and, where relevant, Government of India ministries/PSUs, in strict conformity with the Government Resolution dated 10th July 2023.

4) Scope of Work / Role of a Key Resource Person:-

Depending on the category and area of expertise, a KRP empanelled under this EOI is expected to:

- i) Identify, originate and develop potential G2G business opportunities for MAHAPREET across its ten mandated thematic areas.
- ii) Liaise and coordinate with GoM departments, State PSUs/corporations, Urban Local Bodies, Government of India ministries/agencies and other public authorities to facilitate discussions, approvals and onboarding of projects.
- iii) Support MAHAPREET in preparation and presentation of proposals, concept notes and project reports for consideration of the concerned competent authorities, including the High-Level Committee of Secretaries where applicable.
- iv) Advise on formation of Special Purpose Vehicles, Joint Ventures, Centres of Excellence and Incubation Centres with PSUs/ULBs/corporates, consistent with MAHAPREET's Memorandum and Articles of Association.
- v) Assist in structuring assignments to ensure strict compliance with applicable GoM Government Resolutions, statutes, rules, policies and financial guidelines, so that no liability or financial burden devolves upon the Government.
- vi) Facilitate partnerships with corporates for CSR convergence, technology collaboration and co-investment in MAHAPREET's projects, where the KRP is drawn from the corporate sector.
- vii) Provide sector-specific advisory inputs (e.g., renewable energy, infrastructure, agri-business, urban planning, healthcare, technology) relevant to the KRP's domain of expertise.

The above is illustrative; the specific terms of reference for each KRP will be finalized in the individual Engagement Letter/Agreement based on the assignment(s) undertaken.

5) Categories of Key Resource Persons:-

Category A — Retired AIS Officers: Retired officers of the Indian Administrative Service (IAS), Indian Police Service (IPS) or Indian Forest Service (IFoS), with substantial experience in State/Central Government administration.

Category B — Corporate Domain Experts: Senior professionals from the corporate sector with demonstrated expertise in one or more of MAHAPREET's thematic areas (renewable energy, infrastructure, agri-business, urban planning, healthcare/bio-science, technology, CSR, finance or business development).

6) Eligibility Criteria:-

6.1 Category A — Retired AIS Officers

Parameter	Criteria
Service	Retired officer of IAS / IPS / IFoS (or allied All India Service), of the rank of Divisional Commissioner / Secretary and above rank to Government of Maharashtra or equivalent, preferably.
Experience	Minimum 25 years of administrative service in the State and/or Central Government, with exposure to at least two of MAHAPREET's thematic sectors or to G2G/PPP project facilitation.
Age	Not exceeding 65 years as on the date of application.
Standing	No disciplinary, vigilance or criminal proceeding pending or concluded against adversely; sound physical and mental fitness to undertake the assignment.

6.2 Category B — Corporate Domain Experts

Parameter	Criteria
Qualification	Graduate/Postgraduate degree in Engineering, Management, Finance, Law, Public Policy, Agriculture, Urban Planning or an allied relevant discipline from a recognised university/institute.
Experience	Minimum 15 years of senior leadership experience (CXO/Vice-President level or equivalent) in a relevant sector, with a demonstrated track record in business development, public-private partnerships, PSU engagement or CSR facilitation.
Age	Not exceeding 55 years as on the date of application.
Standing	No conviction, insolvency or debarment by any regulator/government body; no conflict of interest with MAHAPREET's mandate.

MAHAPREET reserves the right to relax the above criteria in respect of candidates of outstanding merit and proven track record, with the approval of the competent authority.

6.3 The KRP Shall Submit Documents in support of their profile:-

- The KRP shall submit the documents in support of their profile as mentioned in clause no. 6
- All documents required to be submitted shall be sealed and self- attested and if required, original copies shall be made available for verification in due course.

7) Number of KRPs to be Empaneled:-

MAHAPREIT proposes to build a panel of Key Resource Persons under Category A and Category B, sector-wise, as per its evolving business requirement. The number of KRPs to be finally engaged, and their sector allocation, shall be decided by the Screening/Selection Committee based on the response received and MAHAPREET's operational needs; empanelment under this EOI does not, by itself, guarantee assignment of work.

8) Mode, Tenure and Basis of Engagement

1. Engagement will be purely contractual/advisory in nature and shall not create an employer-employee relationship between the KRP and MAHAPREET. A KRP shall have no claim to regularization, absorption or any status of MAHAPREET's or the Government's employee/officer at any point in time.
2. KRPs shall be retained by MAHAPREET for its business development work strictly on a success-fee basis (also referred to as "commission" or "facilitation fee") — see Clause 10 below — and not on a fixed salary, consolidated pay or retainer basis.
3. The initial period of empanelment shall be one (1) year from the date of the Engagement Letter, extendable for a further period(s) based on performance and mutual consent, up to a maximum of three (3) years in aggregate, subject to review by MAHAPREET.
4. The engagement may be terminated by either party by giving thirty (30) days' prior written notice, or forthwith in case of misconduct, breach of confidentiality, conflict of interest, or any act prejudicial to the interest of MAHAPREET/Government.

9) Nature of Assignment:-

Engagement under this EOI shall generally be on a non-exclusive basis unless otherwise specified in the Engagement Letter for a particular assignment. A KRP may be required to declare, at the time of application and periodically thereafter, any existing or prospective assignment, directorship, consultancy or business interest that may give rise to a conflict of interest with MAHAPREET's mandate, and shall recuse from any matter where such conflict exists.

10) Success Fee — Basis of Compensation:-

- i) KRPs shall not be entitled to any fixed remuneration, salary, retainer, sitting fee or honorarium of any kind. Compensation shall be strictly limited to a success fee, payable only upon a successful, verifiable outcome directly attributable to the KRP's facilitation.
- ii) A "successful outcome" shall ordinarily mean the signing of a formal MoU, work order, agreement or similar instrument between MAHAPREET and a GoM department/agency/PSU/ULB (or other client) that the KRP has facilitated, resulting in actual receipt of consideration/revenue by MAHAPREET.
- iii) The success fee shall be computed as a percentage of the project value/consultancy fee/revenue actually realized by MAHAPREET from the facilitated assignment, at rates/slabs to be specified in the individual Engagement Letter and approved by

MAHAPREET's competent authority (illustratively, on a graded/slab basis with the percentage tapering as project value increases).

- iv) Success fee shall be payable only after realization of the corresponding payment by MAHAPREET from the client department/agency, and shall be released within a reasonable period thereafter, subject to deduction of applicable taxes (TDS/GST, as applicable) and submission of invoice/claim by the KRP.
- v) No success fee, advance, reimbursement of expenses (including travel, boarding or lodging) or any other payment shall be payable merely for introductions, meetings, applications or efforts that do not culminate in a successful, revenue-fructifying outcome, unless separately and specifically approved by the competent authority.
- vi) This success-fee structure is designed to ensure that MAHAPREET's engagement of KRPs does not create any liability or financial burden on the Government, consistent with Clause 2(a) of Government Resolution No. Sankirna-2022/Pra.Kra.29/Mahamandale dated 10th July 2023, as the fee is contingent and paid solely out of revenue actually realized by MAHAPREET from its own projects.

11) Application Process:-

Interested and eligible candidates may apply in the prescribed Application Format (Annexure-I), enclosing:

- i) Detailed curriculum vitae / bio-data (Annexure-II).
- ii) Self-attested copies of educational qualifications and service/experience certificates.
- iii) In the case of Category A applicants: proof of retirement from AIS and the last three years' Annual Confidential Reports/APARs or equivalent, if available.
- iv) In the case of Category B applicants: proof of current/last held corporate position and relevant assignment/project experience.
- v) Copy of PAN and Aadhaar card, and a recent passport-size photograph.
- vi) Signed declaration of no conflict of interest and acceptance of the success-fee basis of engagement (Annexure-III).

Applications, complete in all respects, should be submitted in a sealed envelope superscribed "Expression of Interest for Engagement of Key Resource Person – Category A / Category B" to the address given in Clause 14 below, or by e-mail as specified therein, so as to reach MAHAPREET on or before the last date mentioned on the cover page. Incomplete applications or applications received after the last date shall not be considered.

12) Selection Process:-

- 1) All applications received within the stipulated timeline shall be scrutinized by a Screening Committee constituted by MAHAPREET for conformity with the eligibility criteria.
- 2) Shortlisted candidates may be called for a personal interaction/interview (in person or through video conferencing) before a Selection Committee constituted by MAHAPREET.
- 3) The Selection Committee's recommendations shall be placed before the competent authority of MAHAPREET for final approval of empanelment.

- 4) MAHAPREET reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications, to relax or modify any of the terms of this EOI, or to withdraw/cancel this EOI at any stage, without assigning any reason, and its decision in this regard shall be final and binding. No correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.

13) General Terms & Conditions:-

- i. KRPs shall, at all times, act in accordance with the Government Resolution dated 10th July 2023, the Finance Department's Government Resolution dated 8th January 2014, and all other applicable GoM/GoI laws, rules, policies and orders.
- ii. KRPs shall maintain strict confidentiality of all official, financial and commercial information that comes to their knowledge during the assignment, both during and after the term of engagement.
- iii. KRPs shall not use their position, contacts or the MAHAPREET/Government's name for any purpose extraneous to the assignment, nor make any commitment on behalf of MAHAPREET or the Government without written authorization.
- iv. No KRP shall claim any right, title or interest in any project, intellectual property or business generated during the engagement, beyond the success fee payable under Clause 9.
- v. This engagement does not confer any statutory, regulatory or decision-making authority on the KRP; all approvals shall continue to rest with the competent authorities of MAHAPREET and the concerned Government department(s).
- vi. MAHAPREET shall not be liable for any loss, expense or damage incurred by the KRP in connection with the assignment, except the success fee specifically payable under Clause 9.
- vii. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with the engagement shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at Mumbai.

- xi. The Proposal will be sealed in an outer envelope which will bear the address of MAHAPREIT Authority, and the name and address of the KRP. It shall bear on top, the following:
“Do not open, except in presence of the Authorized Person of the Authority” If the envelope is not sealed and marked as instructed above, the Authority assumes no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the contents of the Proposal submitted and consequent losses, if any, suffered by the Applicant.
- xii. The Completed Proposal must be delivered on or before the specified time on Proposal Due Date. Proposals submitted by fax, telegram or e-mail shall not be entertained.

15) Conflict of interest:-

- i) The selected KRP / applicant should provide transparent, professional, objective, impartial service and hold MAHAPREIT's paramount with utmost integrity.
- ii) The selected KRP / applicant shall not deploy former contractual employees / contractual employees who have served MAHAPREIT.
- iii) The selected KRP shall not downstream or outsource any part of the scope of work from any agency or the advisors appointed by the MAHAPREIT or sublet the work assigned without MAHAPREIT prior approval in writing.
- iv) Non-disclosure of such an association will lead to termination of KRP. In view of the conflict of Interest, the KRP and its affiliates shall not engage in such consulting activities that conflict with the interest of the MAHAPREIT.
